A limited amount of candy canes will be for sale during the day

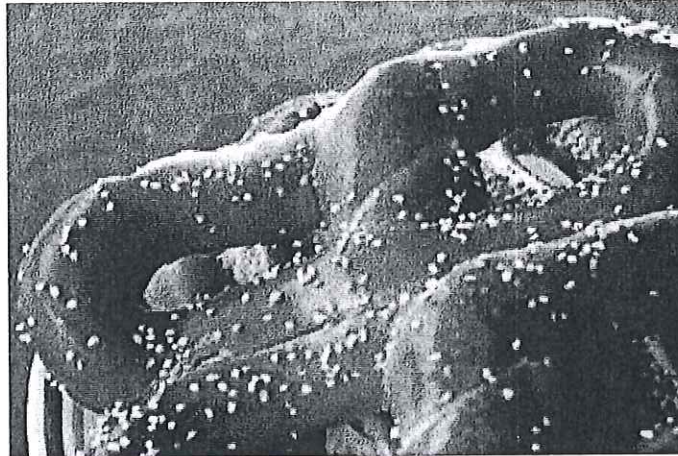
